Semantics Homework – Intro to Linguistics Sem II 2020-2021

Step 1 – Synonymy: Group work

Think of two lexemes that are semantically so similar that you do know why they are different, why you would use one and not the other.

This was done - you chose prison vs. jail

Step 2 – Hypothesis: Group work

Come up with 3 hypotheses as to how they differ in meaning.

This was done - You chose REGSITER, REFERENT, and SEVERITY

Hypothesis 1

Register: Formal vs. Informal

Hypothesis 2

Referent: Institution vs. Building

The group said that we should contrast cell *vs.* building but I fear this will not work since I don't think either prison or jail are often used to refer to a cell. However, the difference between the institution – prison in an abstract sense versus the physical place where people are held, may be interesting.

Hypothesis 3

Severity: More Serious vs. Less Serious

Step 3 – Data: Individual work - See video for help, on website

- a. Choose a corpus (https://www.english-corpora.org/)
- b. Generate a KWIC for the first lexeme then cut and paste the results into Google Sheets
- c. Repeat for second lexeme in new sheet
- d. Clean the data and add Labels for the 3 hypotheses
