Steps for Semantics Project

Part 1: Analysis

This is complete and in the Google sheets

Part 2: Results

a. Choose two hypotheses that you wish to test.

b. Create a cross tabulation of for each hypothesis. Use the so-called "pivot" function in Google sheets.

c. Calculate the proportions and make a histogram showing the difference in use for your two lexemes. This can be done using the insert chart ("100% stacked column chart") in Google sheets.

d. Calculate the *p*-value to see the difference you have observed is significant. This can be done with an online calculator such as: https://www.socscistatistics.com/tests/chisquare/default2.aspx

Part 3: Report

The report should use **IMRaD** - be divided into the 4 subsections 1. Introduction 2. Method. 3. Results. 4. Discussion. It should employ the writing heuristic of KISS (keep it simple and short)

1. Introduction

Explain the questions and propose your hypotheses. Here you may wish to think about our discussions in class. Max 1 or 2 paragraphs.

2. Method

Describe what you did. The problems you encountered. This section is simple if boring. Give as much detail as you think is needed. Include some examples if you think it will improve the explanation. The length here will vary depending on examples, but keep it short and simple.

3. Results.

Here present your cross tabulations for your two hypotheses (no screen shots) and your plots (again, avoid screen shots). Don't forget to add whether any differences observed were significant and give the p value.

4. Discussion

Were your hypotheses supported? If not, why do you think? Is your hypothesis wrong? Was there insufficient data? Was there a problem with the data? If so, do you think that this is the only difference between the lexemes? How could you further test your hypothesis?
